



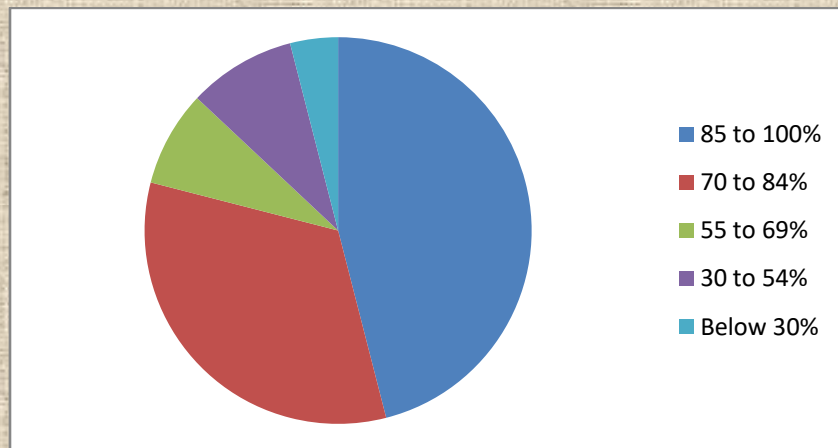
## Nalbari College, Nalbari

### Report of Student Satisfaction Survey

For student satisfaction survey the same questionnaire developed by NAAC consisting of 20 closed ended statements and 01 open ended statement was adopted by the college. Since the total enrolment of the college is around 2800 hence a total of 100 students were randomly selected (10% or 100, whichever is lesser as per NACC guidelines) and data were collected from them. The result is analyzed statement wise and the summary of which is presented below.

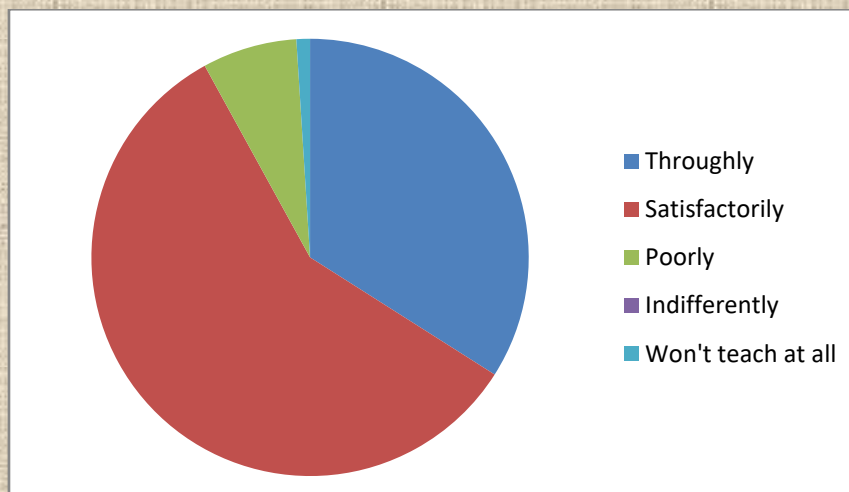
#### **1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?**

- 46% students said that '85 to 100% syllabus was covered'
- 33% students agreed that '70 to 84% syllabus was covered'
- 8% students agreed that '55 to 69% syllabus was covered'
- 9% students agreed that '30 to 54% syllabus was covered' and
- 3% students agreed that 'below 30% syllabus was covered' in the class.



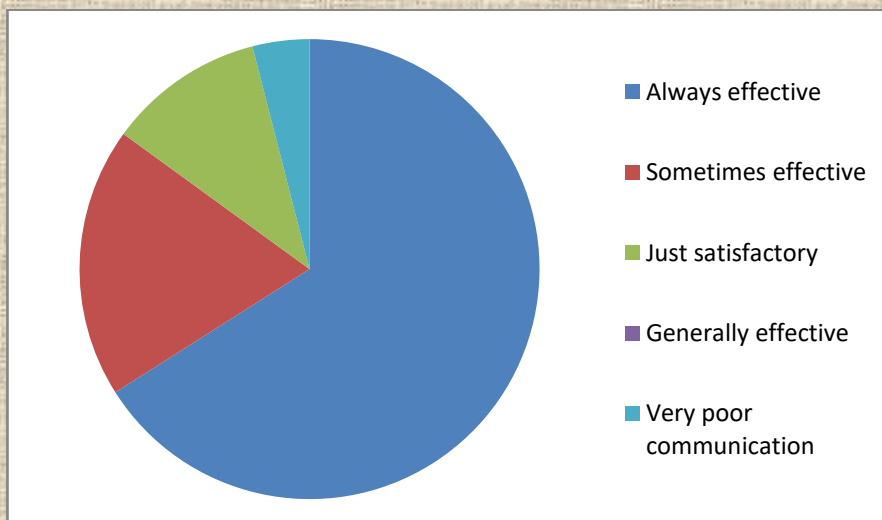
#### **2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?**

- 1% students responded as don't teach at all



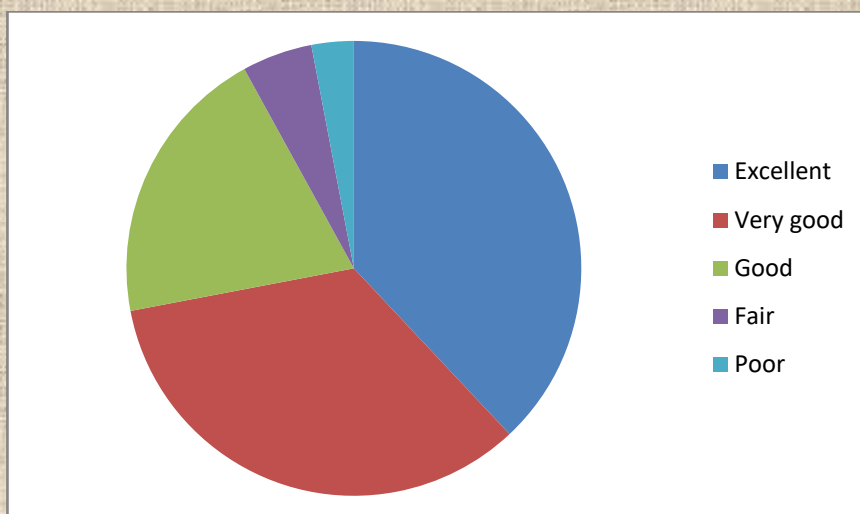
**3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?**

4% students responded as 'very poor communication'



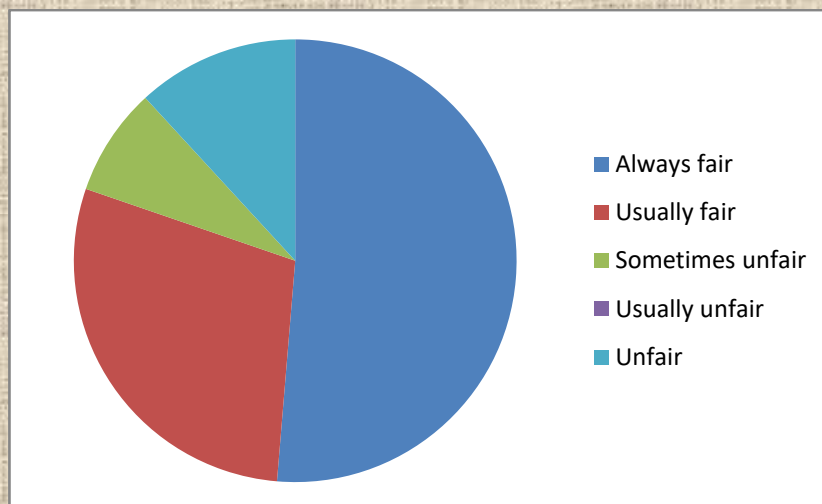
**4. The teachers approach to teaching can best be described as-**

3% students responded as 'poor'



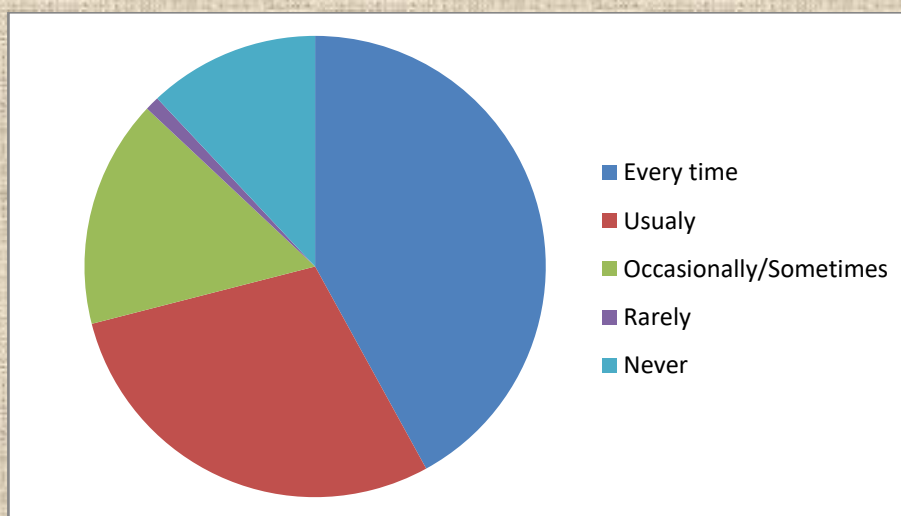
**5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers-**

**6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?**

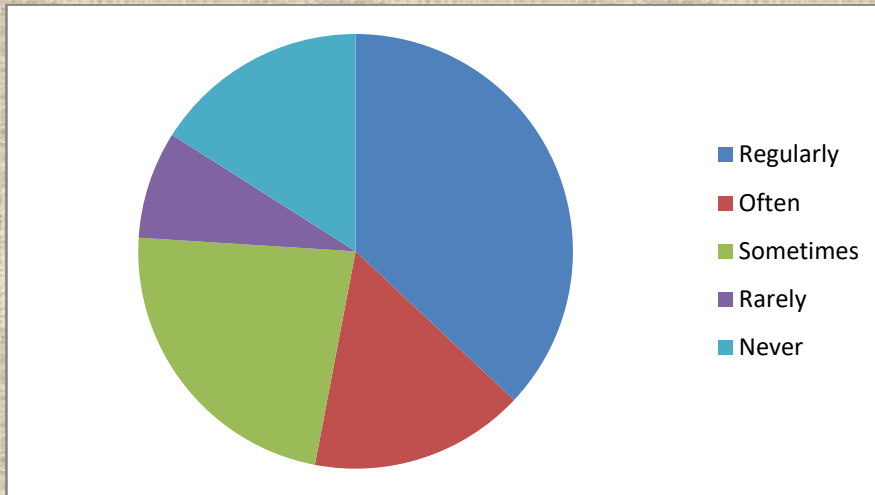
- 42% students responded as 'every time'

- 12% students responded as 'never'





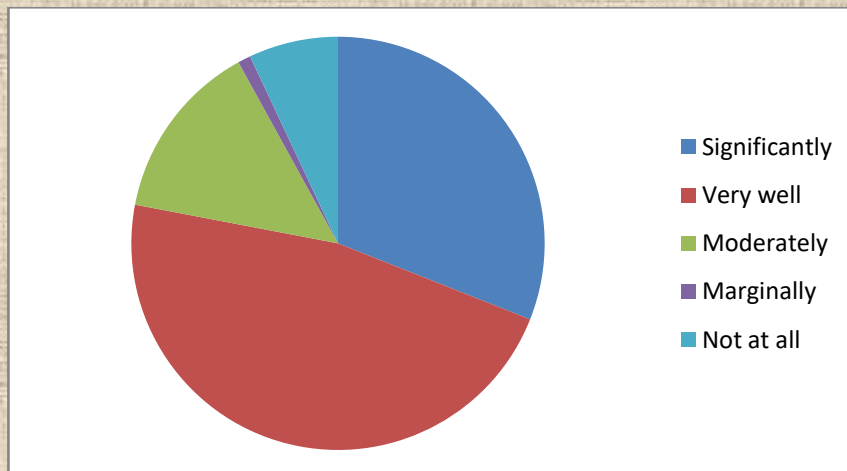
**7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students-**

**9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow-**

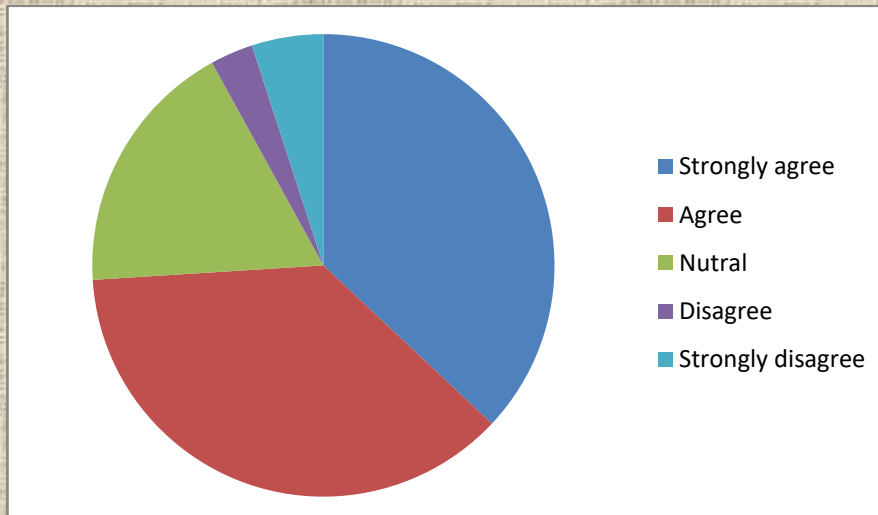
37% students responded as 'strongly agree'

**10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes-**

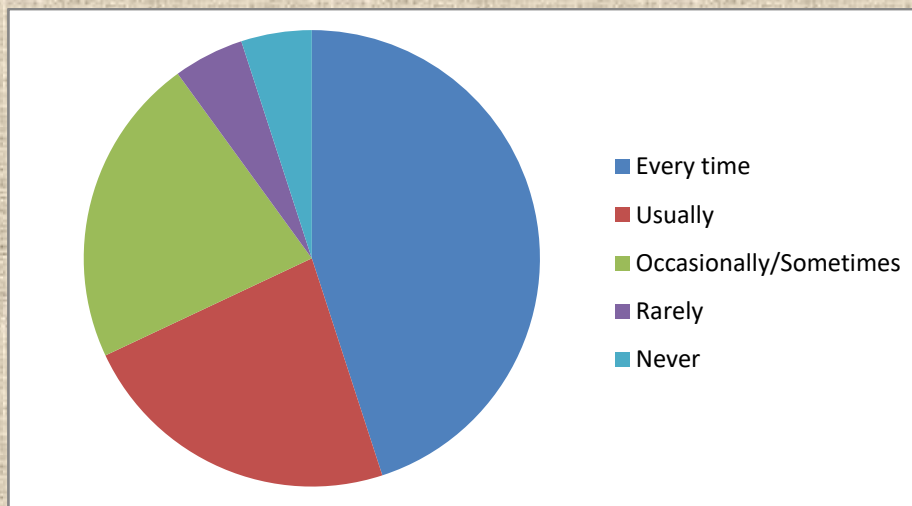
45% students responded as 'every time'

22% students responded as 'occasionally/sometimes'

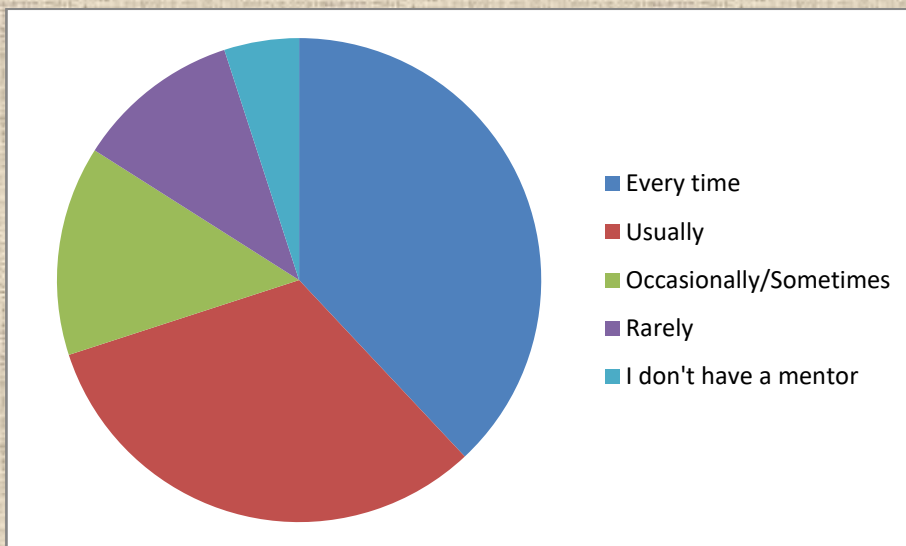
5% students responded as 'rarely' and

5% students responded as 'never'



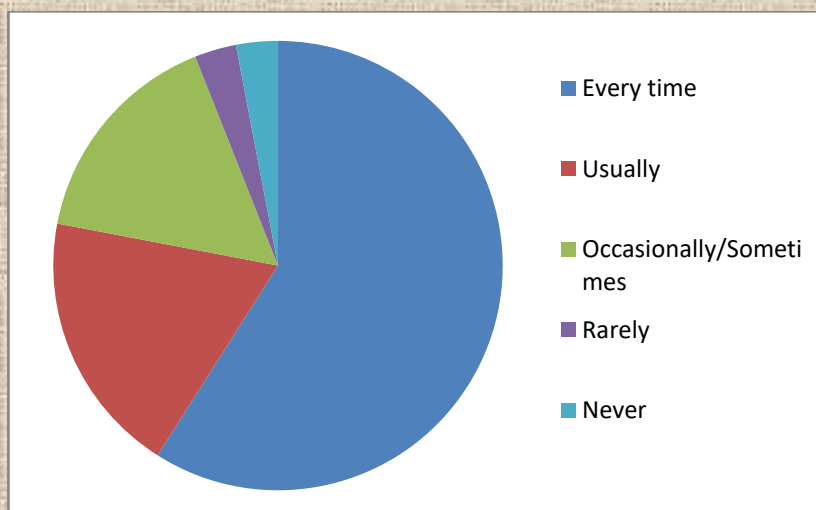
**11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you-**

**12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications-**

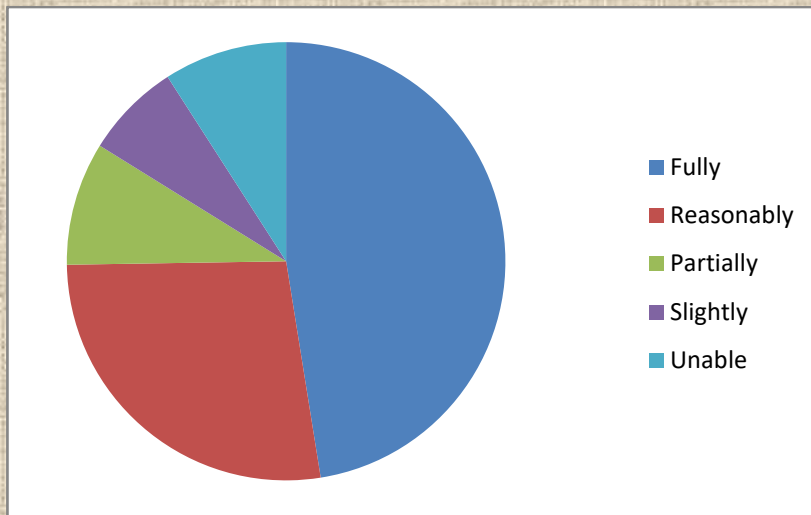
- 59% students responded as 'every time'

- 3% students responded as 'never'.





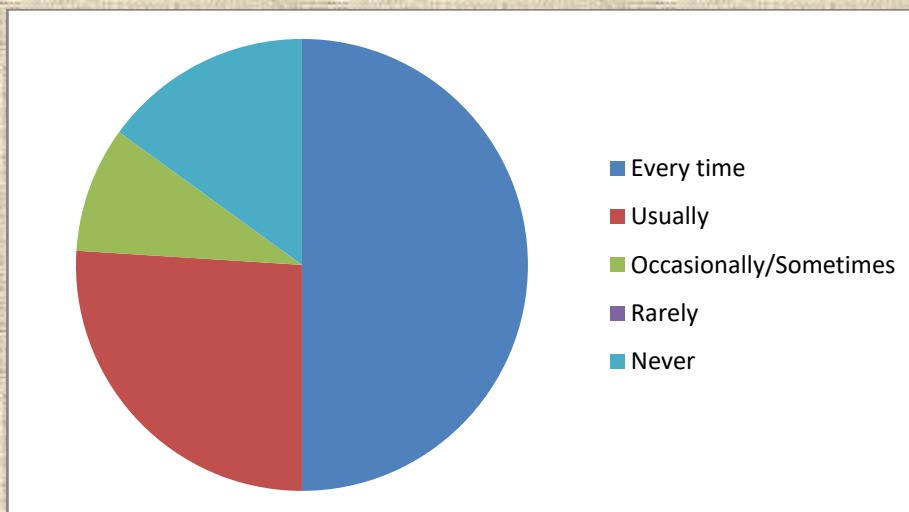
**13. The teachers illustrate identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges-**

9% students responded as 'slightly'.



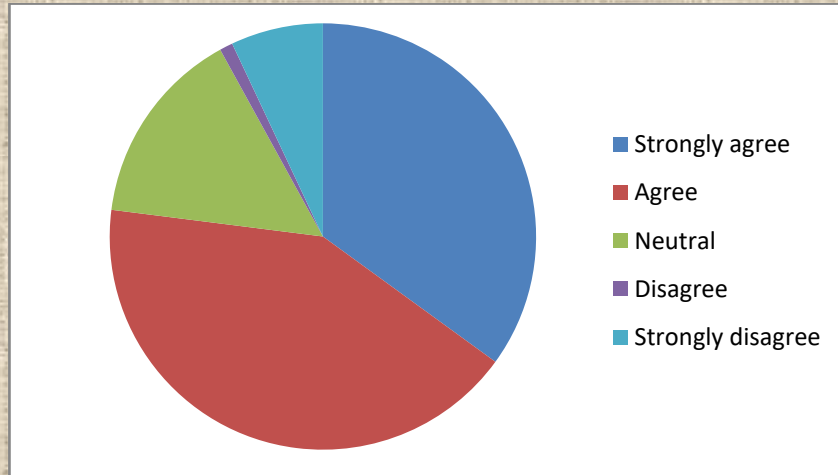
**14. Teachers are able to identify your weakness and help you to overcome them-**

15% students responded as 'never'.



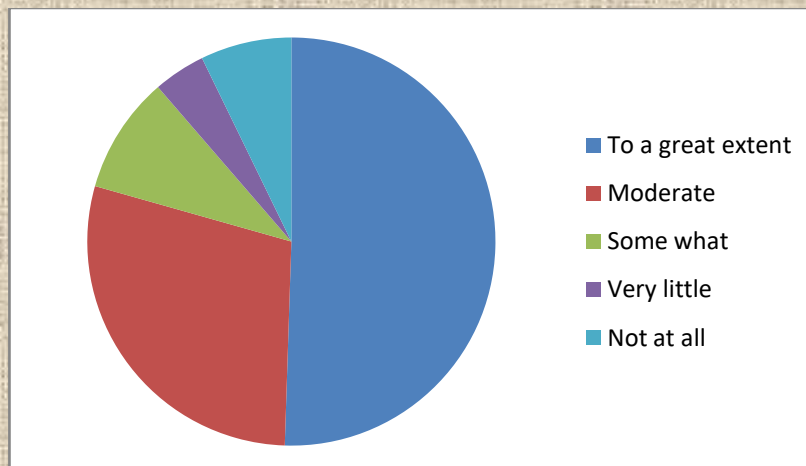
**15. The institution makes effort to encourage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process-**

17. **Teachers encourage you to participate in extra-curricular activities-**

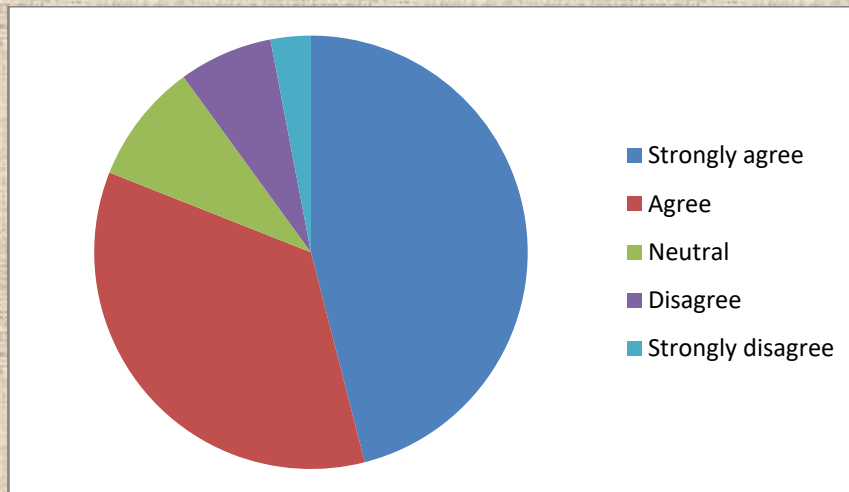
46% students responded as 'strongly agree'

18. **Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world to work-**

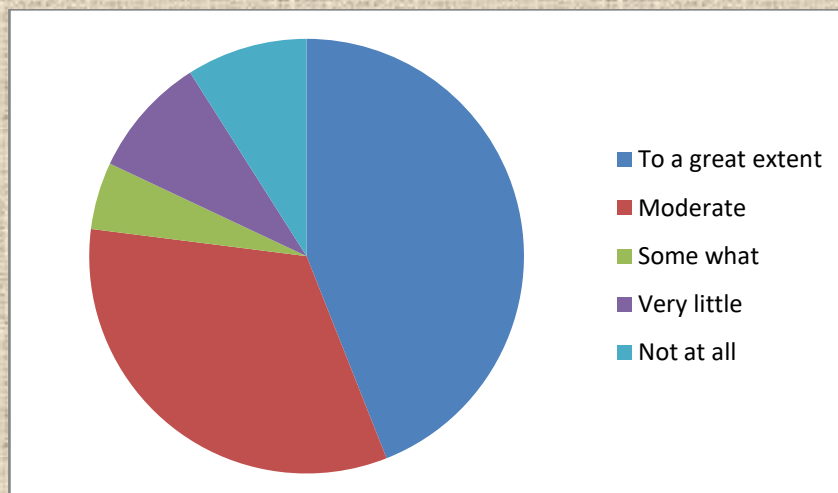
44% students responded as 'to a great extent'

5% students responded as 'somewhat'

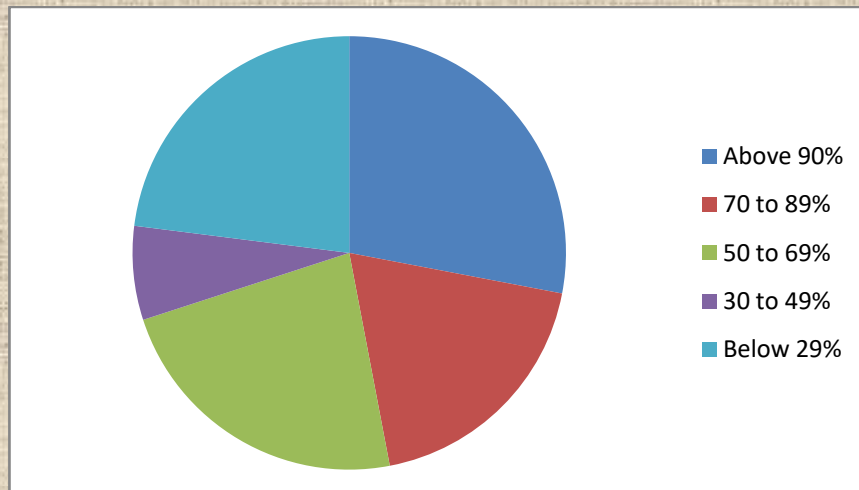
9% students were 'very little' and
