
Sir,

With reference to two earlier notifications issued from the Office of the Academic Registrar dated 04/12/2020 and 31/03/2021 it is to inform you that the papers of the Skill Enhancement Courses will have a theory and Practical mark division of 50-50 i.e. a Theory portion of 50 Marks and a Practical portion of 50 Marks.

Following is the SEC Papers mark allotment break up-

- a) For theory component-50 Marks(to be allotted for 2 assignments of 25 Mark each)
- b) For skill/practical component-50 Marks to be allotted for
 - i) Project Report/Laboratory notebook/Field study Report
 - ii) Presentation
 - iii) Oral/Viva

The theory component marks of 50 should be provided to Gauhati University in the excel sheet as notified earlier and the practical component marks should be uploaded in the gu portal.

NOTIFICATION

This is for the information of all concerned that the following operational modalities are administered for Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) under UG-CBCS, that are listed in the Gauhati University website

1. All the SECs uploaded in the pool for a given semester are open to all students of that semester. Colleges are free to offer any courses from the pool and students can also choose any one of the offered SEC, subject to some discipline specific restrictions.
2. All the Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs) offered will be assigned to a department of Gauhati University.
3. The following suggestions are to be forwarded to concerned departments while attaching a particular SEC. The concerned GU department should ensure that
 - (i) A SEC they have been assigned must not overlap with other SECs.
 - (ii) The SECs are consistent in their course contents, paper code(s) and credit.
 - (iii) The department should suggest prerequisites or restrictions, if any, to a SEC. An SEC paper may have restrictions for students belonging to a particular subject (or discipline). For example, a student with honours in Computer Science will not be eligible to take an SEC on Basics of Computer and DTP. Or a student with regular course on Mathematics will not be eligible to take an SEC on Basic Mathematical Skill. If any restrictions are to be imposed, that has to be mentioned in the syllabus of the concerned course.
- ✓ 4. All SEC papers will have a theory and practical mark division of 50-50 i.e. a theory portion of 50 marks and a practical portion of 50 marks. All other standards would apply as mentioned in the GU CBCS Regulations.
5. The Examination for the theory part of an SEC (for 50 marks) will be held externally by the university as per the usual norms. The evaluation of the practical part of the course (for 50 marks) will be undertaken by the respective college (or institution) which is offering the course.
6. An Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) like *English/MIL Communication* or *Environmental Studies* may not be offered as an SEC. For example, a department/institution cannot suggest an SEC on *English Communication* as it is already an AEC.
7. Course contents of all Skill Enhancement Courses for various semesters are to be uploaded in the CBCS website in a stand-alone format for ready reference.



It is for information of all concerned that in continuation of the notification vide Ref. No. GU/Acad/CBCS/6531 dated 04/12/2020, all Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs) will have a theory and practical mark division of 50-50 i.e., a theory component of 50 marks and a practical component of 50 marks. Therefore, all the concerned/mentoring departments of Gauhati University are requested to update / reframe the SEC syllabus ensuring the following points:


- i. The syllabus for SECs must clearly indicate:
 - (a) Preamble/ Course Description
 - (b) Course Objectives/ Course Outcome
 - (c) Content of the course: detailed description of the Units & guidelines for practical component
 - (d) Teaching-Learning Plan/ Mode of delivery
 - (e) Evaluation Plan/ Examination Pattern: detailed description for theory & practical
 - (f) Books Recommended/Suggested
- ii. The SECs are consistent in their paper code(s) and credit
- iii. No department should offer more than three SEC papers for a particular Semester.
- iv. Course contents of all SECs for various semesters are to be uploaded in the CBCS website in a standalone format for ready reference.
